






Gibraltar Visa Process

- Students will need to apply via: https://visas-immigration.service.gov.uk/product/uk-visit-visa
- Under the heading "Confirm your visa type" you will need to select the following category:
 - Visit, study, work or settle in certain British Crown dependencies,
 Commonwealth countries or British overseas territories
- Choosing these option will lead you to the correct application for Gibraltar.
- At the end of the application you will be asked to pay the relevant fee. You will also have to book an appointment at a UK Visa Application Centre of your choice.


ACCOMMODATION

- Free broadband and utility bills are included





ENTRY REQUIRMENTS

Typically for Undergraduate Programmes

- A-level: BCC, 5 GCSE's
- Higher Secondary School Certificate/Standard XII with an overall average of 60–65% to include a minimum of five subjects at 40% or higher.
- Strong communications skills
- Basic IT skills, such as word-processing, email and Internet.
- English IELTS 6.5 (or equivalent). Pre- sessional English sessions are also available via our Language Centre.
