## CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

### • General information about the employment market:

The Logistics and Transport Industry is dynamic and operating smoothly. Currently responsible for over 2 million jobs in France, the market is set to expand by around 1.5% per year.

The constant growth of E-commerce supported by new technologies, related consumer habits and the impact of Big Data are creating change and causing companies, particularly in industry, to rethink how they are organised and how their systems operate.

New skills such as interdisciplinary expertise are expected, with more capacity to progress in an international and multicultural environment where mobility and the ability to bring together virtual teams are keys to success.
