

Capt. Sansarchandra Chabe profile

Capt Sansarchandra Chaube is Head of Marine Services at APSEZL, Mundra. He is a Master Marine (Foreign Going). He began his career as a deck cadet in Century Shipping in the year 1991. He got command of a ship in the year 2004 after which he quit sea and took up the job of harbour pilot with various ports such as Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust, Mumbai Port Trust and finally APSEZL in the year 2008.

Since 2008, he has been working with APSEZ. The switch over to piloting job allowed him to gain insight in to Port Operations which is very closely related to the Shipping Industry. He joined APSEZL, Mundra as DGM (Marine Operations) in the year 2010 and was promoted as GM and Head of Marine Services, in the year 2013. His primary responsibility is to ensure safe navigation of ships in Mundra Port, conservancy of Mundra Port Harbour, providing technical inputs for construction of new berths and terminals, meeting Marine Department's compliance requirement and achieving budgeted targets.

APSEZL, Mundra in the year FY 2013-14 became the largest Commercial Port in the country and the first commercial port to handle 100 Million tons of cargo leaving behind all the major ports in the process. Mundra Port handles the largest ships of all types which can possibly call at any Port in the world. Mundra Port has maintained an impeccable safety record over the years. Capt Sansarchandra Chaube has the distinction of handling the largest container ships to have ever called India.
